## WINEMAKER NOTES

Pronounced "Guh-voorts-trah-mee-ner," this grape originated in Germany. It is similar to Riesling and Moscato in that it tends to have a very floral, even sweet, aroma. It is often made into sweet or dessert style wine but can be made into very complex dry wines too.


The 2023 Gewürztraminer is made with a more fruit forward approach, not quite dry but not sweet either. It is the perfect weekday wine.

### TASTING NOTES

This Gewürztraminer has the color of honeysuckle and aromas of clove and sweet baking spice. This wine is full of flavors of tangerine, ruby red grapefruit, and nectarine. Soft, with just the right amount of crispness and a hint of sweetness, it has a finish of leechee.
