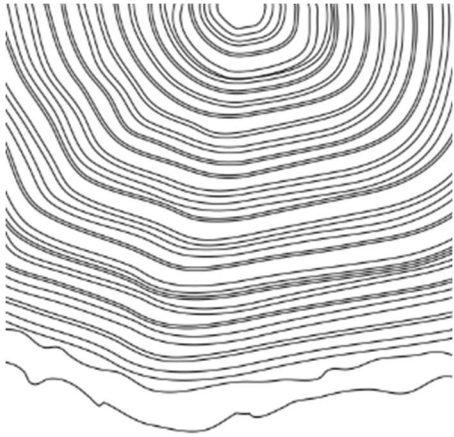


# Sweet Moscato 2023



## WINEMAKER NOTES

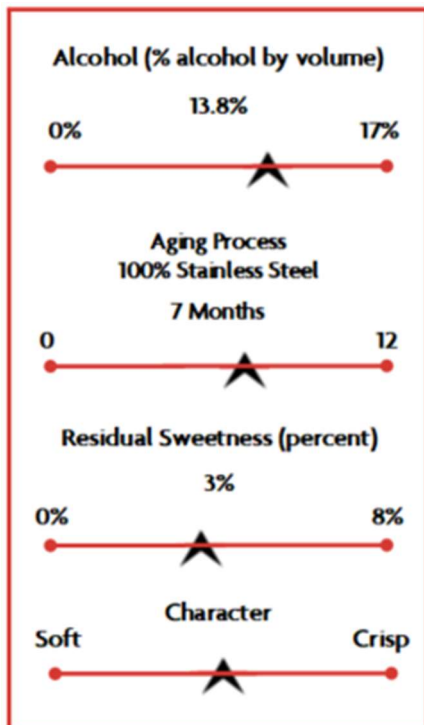
There are over 200 grape varieties belonging to the Muscat family. Muscat grapes are not just grown for wine production but also for raisins and table grapes. Although the variety is best known for making sweet wines, it can also be used to make crisp dry, sparkling, and fortified dessert wines as well. Its versatility and hardiness keep it a staple among wine-producing regions across the world. The muscat varieties used in this Sweet Moscato are Muscat Blanc and Muscat Canelli.

With a soft yellow hue, this Sweet Moscato clings to the glass with delicate legs. The aroma is all about the tropics invoking memories of papaya, mango, and exotic flowers. The flavors are silky with layered notes of pineapple, sweet nectarines, with a mandarin orange finish.

Pair with tropical fruit sushi rolls, hamburger with goat cheese, BBQ baked beans, honey-glazed carrots, porkchop with apples, or orange mascarpone layer cake.
